

► FEBRUARY 2019 BARCKLEY STOREY, M.D. PROSTATE HEALTH

Dr. Storey is a graduate of the University of Kentucky. He received his M.D. degree from the University of Louisville where he did his post graduate training in Urology. He is Board Certified and a member of the American Urologic Association and the Florida Medical Association. He specializes in a broad range of urologic conditions affecting men and women. 2019 RULE CHANGES- COMMENTS:

Knee height drop (shoulder not an option). In club level play players have OB option to drop a ball in fairway where the ball entered OB and take a 2 stroke penalty.

Flagstick may be left in the hole for any putt (but must not be tended when left in). When in Red Staked Hazards, grounding your

club as part of your shot or removing loose impediments is allowed.

When in Sand Traps or Bunkers golfers may now move loose impediments but they still may not ground the club as part of the shot. Cannot in any way test sand!

<u>Unplayable Lies</u> remedy now allows 2 options: dropping ball within a 2 club length radius semicircle no closer than at the spot of the lie, or on a line formed by flag and the unplayable lie as far back as you wish. Then at selected "go back" spot, player drops in a club radius circle. Either of above is a 1 stroke penalty. **GREAT OPTIONS FOR LIES IN THE "BUNCH** GRASS", THE HUGE HIBISCUS MIXED IN WITH TALL PALMS, AND OTHER THICK PLANTINGS SO PREVALENT ON THE HIBISCUS COURSE!

SPRING SCRAMBLE MONDAY APRIL 29TH AT LELY MUSTANG COURSE!!

HANDICAP ISSUES: Many of our golfers are not getting all their scores into the HC system. Here's how our HC system works.

- 1. Score cards must be placed in the Gray Pouch labeled MMC Monday Golf kept at Hibiscus Pro shop desk. In the Summer that pouch is moved to Lely's covered stand at the golf bag drop.
- 2. For a score card to be used for HC it must have LAST names, DATE, TEE BOX played, and be both SIGNED and ATTESTED by members of the playing group.
- **USGA** Equitable Scoring rules and guidelines.
- 4. Only scores of MMC members or MMC golf only non-resident players will be processed.
- 5. The Handicap Chair then transfers the scores (corrected if necessary) to a spreadsheet with LAST and FIRST name, play DATE.
- 6. That data is sent to Roger Fredericks who enters it into a program that calculates players INDEX and specific HANDICAP for Lely Agua and **Hibiscus Gold Tees.**
- 7. Roger generates a report to Al Vacio who, after reviewing it for accuracy, publishes it. **NOTE**: If you have been turning in score cards that are not legible, or missing last names, date, or signatures...they are discarded. We cannot reconstruct or chase down missing information. Also, score cards from Friday TGIF play are not automatically entered into MMC HC system. If you want your Friday play score to go into MMC system keep 2 score cards. Place one in the TGIF pouch. Then place the second (duplicate) score card in the MMC gray pouch. You may have to ask for the MMC pouch because it is not left out on Fridays. It is stored in a folder that's in the file rack on the window credenza to left of the check in registers.
