## The Bad Guys are Still Phishing...Beware! A

while back I wrote about an email scam that was recurring. Members were receiving an email saying it was from me, and indicated that I wanted them to buy cash cards or give money for an apparently good cause. These types of email are an ongoing scam known as "phishing". Phishing is a deceptive attempt by an unknown user to provoke the email recipient into engaging with it by either opening an attachment, clicking on a malicious URL (web address), or taking some other action. I know of no way to stop these attempts. I can only advise that if you receive something indicating it is from a person you know and it asks you to take steps that seem at odds with your knowledge of or relationship with that person, first verify the email address of the sender in the "from" portion of the email. If you don't recognize that email address you're on notice it's not from whom it purports to be. It is also a good idea to contact the sender...a person whose email address is probably in your contacts...to verify the communication. Whatever path you choose, DON'T open a suspicious attachment or go to a suspicious URL until you get outside verification of the identity of the sender.



### NOVEMBER 2019 FIRE CHIEF PETER HAYDEN FDNY RESPONSE TO 9/11

Peter Hayden retired as Chief of Department of the FDNY after 38 years of service. He retired in 2006. On 9/11 Chief Hayden was the division commander flower Manhattan, an area that covers the world trade center. He was on duty at the time of the attack and supervised operations in the North Tower, the first building hit. After the collapse of World Trade Center Towers, Chief Hayden was promoted to Assistant Chief of Operation and supervised the rescue and recovery operations at "GroundZero":

Chief Hayden will discuss the events of that day and the many months afterward. He will describe damage done to the department, the efforts to rebuild the department and to prepare the FDNY for future terrorist attacks.
