

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

MMC By-Laws Have Changed. The changes to our by-laws that were recommended by the Board of Directors in October were unanimously approved at the general meeting of the membership on November 14th. The complete set of by-laws as amended is on the MMC website. Let me summarize generally the couple of changes that will take place: First the club membership year will now follow the calendar year. We'll have only one more dues-billing in the May-June period and that will be next spring. At that time, you will get a billing for 1 ½ years dues (\$90) and that will pay you through calendar year 2021. Then in November-December 2021 we'll begin the new calendar year dues-paying cycle. Second the annual meeting and election of officers will be held in January beginning in 2020. By the time you read this, the board of directors

will likely have approved a slate of candidates to recommend to the membership at the December general meeting. Those candidates elected in January will take office on the following May 1st and serve one-year terms.

COMO Jaskiewicz is a graduate of the United States Coast Guard Academy. He was the founder and CEO of one of the largest Private Security Agencies in California prior to his retirement in 1976. He has been a full time resident of Marco Island since 1996 with his wife Barbara. Walter has been a member of the USCG Auxiliary Marco Island for over 20 years. 
MARCH 2020 DR.THOMAS SALVUCCI CARDIAC HEALTH
