Insert your repair tool at the edge of the depression and lean your tool towards the center of the depression, do this around the edge always working toward the center of the depression then tap down with your putter. DO NOT LIFT UP THE CENTER OF THE BALL MARK AS THIS WILL DESTROYS THE ROOTS. Another tip on fixing divots in the fairway is fill it with sand than smooth it out. This will help the mowers in keeping the blades sharp.
