PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

How Quickly Things Can Change. It seems like just yesterday we were enjoying all that Marco Island has to offer in the winter. Restaurants, shops, golf, fishing, theater, gatherings of all kinds. The Marco Men's Club had a calendar which was packed full with events.

Then we all learned the harsh realities of Coronavirus 19 and how deadly COVID-19 can be for people over age 60. In the past three weeks, daily living on the island has dramatically changed after the continuing updates from the CDC, NIH, and state and local governments. If you have been following their advice, you are now self-isolating, avoiding close social contacts, and being very cautious in general if you have to leave your home.

Thanks to Jerry Swiacki, our Program Chairman, our speaker at the March general meeting was Dr. Gregory Poland. He is the Director of the Mayo Vaccine Research Group in Rochester, MN. His specialty includes virology, vaccinology, and immunology. Dr. Poland's well-prepared presentation included much needed information about the origin of Coronavirus 19, its spread, the danger it poses to us living here in Florida, and things we can do to help prevent us from acquiring the disease.

I won't try to give medical advice to any of our members. If you have questions, you can get a lot of information about COVID-19 online from the CDC website. But I would be remiss if I didn't at least repeat simple warnings given by Dr. Poland and which are almost now part of our daily news stream:

- -Wash your hands properly and frequently for 20 seconds
- -Avoid touching your face
- -Cover your cough or Cough into tissue and

then throw away the tissue
-avoid close encounters with people
-avoid large groups

MMC HAS HAD TO CANCEL EVENTS.

Bocce and Golf Leagues. Theater Refunds. The MMC board determined that the club would take on the responsibility to pursue refunds and/or credit for cancelled theater performances.

Members should not individually contact the theater venues. The club will refund money paid for tickets for our theater events as soon as it secures a refund or credit for a cancelled performance. As of this writing, refunds checks are in process for those who bought tickets to *Tusk-The Music of Fleetwood Mac* and *Come from Away*.

The Club just learned from the Sugden Theater that the 4/5/20 scheduled performance of *Bye Bye Birdie* is cancelled. Once MMC receives its refund or ticket credit, the club will begin refunding ticket payments to our members who hold tickets to that performance.

The club has just learned from Artis Naples that the 4/18/20 performance of *A Bronx Tale* and the 4/20/20 performance by *Chris Botti* are cancelled. Once cancellation is confirmed by Artis Naples and MMC receives a refund or credit the club will begin refunding ticket payments to our members who hold tickets for those events.

MMC Board held a telephone conference board meeting on 4/2/20. Fifth-Third Bank is not permitting groups as large as ours to use its conference room until further notice. The board voted unanimously to cancel the Mickey Mouse Club Party scheduled for 4/23/20, the General Meeting and the free installation lunch for members set for 5/14/20, and the planned Date Night set for 5/20/20. The New Board/Old Board luncheon, a club tradition, will also be rescheduled to a time later in autumn.

The board will of course be monitoring the Coronavirus 19 news and will continue to update our membership regarding club activities. Let's all hope that we'll be able to begin holding more of our fun events real soon. 
