Tracy Frazzano holds two Master of Arts degrees and a Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science and Sports Management from Rutgers University. She earned her first Master's in 2003 in Human Resources Training development from Seton Hall University; and her second, in 2010 in Security Studies (Homeland Security and Defense) from the United States Naval Postgraduate School Center for Homeland Defense & Security (CHDS).

Professional Experience:

Tracy L. Frazzano was appointed the Chief of Police for the Marco Island Police department in August of 2019 based on a national search. Prior to her selection, she was a 25-year member of the Montclair Police Department (New Jersey) serving as Deputy Chief. Her police career includes varied assignments in patrol, investigative, and community policing. Within the Montclair Police Department, she made history as its first female Detective, Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain, and Deputy Chief. Chief Frazzano is a graduate of the FBI National Academy (Session 261) and received the distinguished graduate award, given to the top 1% of the class. In addition to serving on the Board of Directors for the Southwest Florida Police Chiefs Association, she also serves on the board for The Shelter for Abused Women and Children and the Florida Criminal Justice Executive Policy Board.

Thanks to Ken Burnham for coordinating Mondays at Hibiscus in November.


