February 10, 2022 Pat Rutledge Marco Island Historical Society

Pat is the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Marco Island Historical Society (MIHS). She and her husband, Ron, came to Marco Island 12 years ago after spending 40 years with a Fortune 500 Corporation. She retired as Vice President of Operations for the Financial Services Division of Pitney Bowes. Pat joined the Historical Society in 2012 first as a volunteer and then as a member of the MIHS Board of Directors in 2013 serving as Chair of the Marketing and Communications Committee. In 2015 and 2016, she served as Board President, Volunteer Executive Director and continued as Marketing & Communications Chair, From 2017 to present, Pat continues as the Historical Society's leader promoted from Executive Director to CEO in 2021.

Pat is a graduate of Leadership Marco Class XIII (13) and Greater Naples Leadership Class XVIII (18). She was named The Marco Island Eagle Volunteer of the Year in 2016. That same year Pat and Ron were recognized by the Noontime Rotary Club's Spirit Award for their contributions to the betterment of the Marco Island community. She also received the 2019 Collier County "She Made a Difference" Award as a woman who made a significant difference in Collier County. Pat is a Past President of the Marco

Island Noontime Rotary Club and was named Rotary District 6960 President of the Year – Small Club in 2019.

March 10, 2022 Dr John Esposito Reconciling Islam and Christianity

University Professor, Professor of Religion and International Affairs and of Islamic Studies at Georgetown University, John L. Esposito is Founding Director of the Alwaleed Center for Muslim-Christian Understanding and The Bridge Initiative: Protecting pluralism – Ending Islamophobia in the Walsh School of Foreign Service. S. Rajaratnam Professor of Strategic Studies for 2019, Rajaratnam School of International Studies, Singapore. Previously, he was Loyola Professor of Middle East Studies, College of the Holy Cross.

Past President of the American Academy of Religion and Middle East Studies Association of North America, Dr Esposito has been a member of the World Economic Forum's Council of 100 Leaders and the E.C. European Network of Experts on De-Radicalisation, a Senior Scientist for The Gallup Center for Muslim Studies, and an ambassador for the UN Alliance of Civilizations. He has served as a consultant to the U.S. Department of State and other agencies, European and Asian governments, corporations, universities and media worldwide. Editor-in-Chief of Oxford Islamic Studies Online and Series Editor of The Oxford Library of Islamic Studies, he served as Editor-in-Chief of The Oxford Encyclopedia of the Islamic World; The Oxford Encyclopedia of the Modern Islamic World, The Oxford History of Islam, The Oxford Dictionary of Islam, and The Islamic World: Past and Present.

Dr Esposito has published more than 55 books.

Esposito's interviews and articles with newspapers, magazines, and the media in the U.S., Europe, Asia, and the Middle East: The Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, The Washington Post, The Economist, the Guardian, the Times of London, CNN, ABC, Nightline, CBS, NBC, and BBC. A native of Brooklyn, N.Y., he currently resides in Washington, D.C. with his wife Dr. Jeanette P. Esposito.

Pace of Play: This is an ongoing issue. I've attached an article I read from the USGA online that can help us. Let's always play in 4 hours.

These are the highlights from the USGA article:

- 1. Hit when ready. Play ready golf.
- 2. Plan your shot before you get to your ball.
- 3. Keep your pre-shot routine short.
- 4. "Aim to play in 20 seconds", from club selection until you play your shot.
- 5. "When sharing a cart, use a buddy system". Drop your playing partner off at his ball and then go to your ball.
- 6. Keep up with the group in front of you.


