Tom Kramer has been a member for a number of years, and hosted two events recently, a dinner night, last fall and a theater event this month. **Chris Hanson** joined late 2019; he has stepped up to be Golf Chairman and is hosting his first Scramble. Mike Ballenger and Arne Sandberg each hosted an event this past year, and you

elected them to Vice-Presidents positions. Rick Johnson has asked to take Bocce of my hands. This is just a small list of Guys stepping up to do their part. I thank you guys and encourage others to say "yes" and do their part. Hosting is not difficult and if your wife really likes to put on a party, we are looking for you.

June 8, 2022 Mr. Mike McNees City Manager Marco Island

STAY INFORMED! Come learn more about your community and what it takes to run it! The Marco Men's Club welcomes Mr. Mike McNees, City Manager of Marco Island on Wednesday, June 8, 2022!

Mike McNees assumed the role of Marco Island City Manager on July 1, 2019. Before that he served as City Manager for Melbourne on Florida's Space Coast.

McNees started his thirty-plus year career in public service in the early 1980's when he moved from the private sector into an entry-level job in Collier County Government. 17 years later he left his position as Assistant Collier County Manager to become City Manager in Sarasota, Florida, a position he held for six years. He then moved to the mountains to become the first County Administrator of Blaine County, Idaho which covers 2800 square miles and includes the Sun Valley ski resort.

In 2009 Mike was recruited by a former associate to the position of Chief Operating Office for USA Track and Field, and a year later was unexpectedly thrust into the Chief Executive Officer's role. In two years in that position, he took Team USA to the Pan American Games in Guadalajara, Mexico, and to World Championship events in Istanbul, Turley and Daegu, South Korea, while negotiating the necessary contracts for the execution of the 2012 USA Olympic Track and Field Trials in Eugene, Oregon. McNees subsequently returned to public service in Melbourne in early 2013.

Mike is a native Hoosier who received a degree in Chemistry from Indiana University, where he was a Big Ten Conference Champion in track and field. He served as Assistant Track Coach at Louisiana Tech University while earning his Masters' Degree in Business Administration.

He would serve six years with the NH National Guard with the 397th Medical Detachment. He would obtain the rank of Staff Sergeant (E6) and would be in charge of the Detachment's Flight Medics on Huey Helicopters within the state.

"Stef" would spend four years as a career firefighter with the City of Concord Department before teaching history two years before beginning an almost 40-year career in sales and

marketing for two U.S. manufacturers of fire and EMS apparatus and equipment.

Over the years he has been very active within the community serving on a number of committees and boards throughout Marco, including the YMCA's Board of Directors, Transition Committee for Facilities for the City, Master Planning Committee for the Veterans Community Park, City of Marco Island Budget Review Committee, the Disaster Relief Fund Raising Committee for Hurricane Katrina Victims, the Marco Island Sunrise Rotary, Board of Directors for Sunrise Rotary, the Original Veterans Memorial Planning Committee, President of the Board of Directors for the Town House Square Condo Association and for 16 years the Chairman of Christmas Island Style.

Up until two years ago Stef was an avid motorcyclist, having traveled by two wheels throughout the country and writing blogs while on those trips. Golf and boating have also been great loves of his.


