

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Let's talk about the elephant in the room, my wife's passing. Many have lost a wife, pardon me, it's my first time. I have always anticipated she would precede me, because of her health issues, I was thinking ten to twelve years from now. Reality check! We were to celebrate our 50th Anniversary on the Australian cruise with the kids; we have been a "thing" since 10th grade.

Donna did have an ovarian cancer, ten years. It developed malignant tumors in her belly area. Surgery was able to remove them and chemo was able to limit them. It was not her killer. she was fading over the past two years, starting with a very bad bout with COVID. The decline was at a rate that was difficult to notice. It was

measured in her endurance. Then in November the pace of decline accelerated. It coincided with intestinal issues. In January she spent a week in the hospital, tests, tests, and more tests. Nothing found.

May 7th, she had an event, perhaps the result of a bladder infection or in conjunction with blood issues, off to the ER. Doctors fought blood issues, too thick too thin, clotting in samples, not enough hemoglobin, too low on platelets, and early on mini strokes. Then finally a bone marrow biopsy was performed. After 33 ICU days, the real killer was revealed, Lymphoma. Look up the symptoms, Donna had them. She was "wiped" by this time. In Donna's own words when

she heard the diagnosis "no more treatment". Notwithstanding, the hospital wasn't offering treatment. Hospice was now the path forward. On her first evening in Hospice with a drug or two in her, she said "I'm comfortable". Ninety hours later, she passed.

I have to write this because I get too emotional to say it. Near the end, she had not accepted that she was dying, but she knew she was. In one statement she noted "When I get out, I'm going to write a thank you to everyone that sent a card." And in the next statement she cried, "My kids are moving to Florida and I won't be here."

It hurts; it's like losing your right hand. I'll survive, but looking for a cook.....someone right-handed.

Thank you to all that sent a note or attended the service, it helps to hear from people who care. The kids moving to Florida will help too. Dry your eyes and let's move on.

June had 3 activities. **Mike Levine** hosted a Co-Ed lunch at
Cocomos with 21in attendance. **Tim Clune** hosted a Father's Day

dinner with 18 in attendance. **Dave Tobiasz** hosted "Something Rotten" at the Sugden with 47 attending as well as 47 for dinner.

I'm a bit concerned about Father's Day. Why was attendance so muted? I suspect many had family in. I personally had a conflict. Perhaps the price? At your next opportunity, share with me, why you chose not to attend. Perhaps we need a new event for June, I know, Juneteenth!



He would serve six years with the NH National Guard with the 397th Medical Detachment. He would obtain the rank of Staff Sergeant (E6) and would be in charge of the Detachment's Flight Medics on Huey Helicopters within the state.

"Stef" would spend four years as a career firefighter with the City of Concord Department before teaching history two years before beginning an almost 40-year career in sales and marketing for two U.S. manufacturers of fire and EMS apparatus and equipment.

Over the years he has been very active within the community serving on a number of committees and boards throughout Marco, including the YMCA's Board of Directors, Transition Committee for Facilities for the City, Master Planning Committee for the Veterans Community Park, City of Marco Island Budget Review Committee, the Disaster Relief Fund Raising Committee for Hurricane Katrina Victims, the Marco Island Sunrise Rotary, Board of Directors for Sunrise Rotary, the Original Veterans Memorial Planning Committee, President of the Board of Directors for the Town House Square Condo

Association and for 16 years the Chairman of Christmas Island Style.

Be on the lookout for the entry form for the Fall Scramble in the weeks ahead.


MMC Golf June Numbers
