

The board of directors has initiated a change to the Bylaws. Any change to the bylaws requires a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present. This will be voted on at the January annual meeting. Below is the current text and the proposed text.


Current SECTION 7:

To encourage general participation of the members and also to gain the advantages of experience, neither the President nor the Treasurer shall hold the same position for more than two (2) consecutive terms. No Board member shall serve, more than four (4) consecutive terms in the same elected position on the Board.

Proposed SECTION 7:

To encourage general participation of the members and also to gain the advantages of experience, the President shall not hold the position for more than two (2) consecutive terms. No other Board member shall serve more than Five (5) consecutive terms in the same elected position on the Board. (Amended January, 2023)

December 14, 2022 Jack Mulvena President & CEO of Naples Zoo

Jack Mulvena is the president and CEO of Naples Zoo at Caribbean Gardens in Naples, FL. Mr. Mulvena previously served for 20 years as the executive director of the Rhode Island Zoological Society and Roger Williams Park Zoo in Providence, R.I.

Holding an MBA from the University of Rhode Island and a bachelor's degree from Boston College, Jack joined the Naples Zoo in May of 2013, a critical time in the Zoo's history, with attendance growing and major expansion planned. Attracted by the Naples Zoo's long-standing commitment to global, national, and local conservation, the foundation upon which the Getzlaff family built the zoo, Mr. Mulvena has developed programs that help conserve species such as cheetahs, tigers, giraffes, lions and leopards in their range countries.

February 8, 2023 Susan Suarez President & CEO Holocaust Museum & Cohen Education Center

Our February speaker, Susan Suarez, joined The Holocaust Museum & Cohen Education Center in August 2017. Susan has more than 30 years of nonprofit experience. In 2021, Susan was named the Fundraising Executive of the Year by the local chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals. The Holocaust Museum serves more than 30,000 students and visitors annually at the Museum, at schools, and in the community. The Museum is consistently ranked in the top 10 of best things to do in Naples on TripAdvisor.

During Susan's tenure, the Museum conducted a successful capital campaign, purchased, and moved to a larger facility. The new, larger Museum is nearly 10,000 square feet and includes its permanent collection with artifacts and stories from local Survivors and Liberators, special temporary exhibits, and classroom space for student programs and lectures. The Museum partners with many local groups in its mission to teach the lessons of the Holocaust to inspire action against bigotry, hatred and violence.

The automobiles are fully operational and displayed free of protective barriers, allowing visitors intimate access.

Tom, a former attorney from the Boston, MA area, came to live in Naples, FL with his wife Mary eight years ago. In 2019, he joined a group of volunteers at the institute and the rest is history! 
