#### Current


#### SECTION 7:

January 11, 2023 Craig Woodward Partner in Charge: Woodward, Pires & Lombardo Respected Marco Island Historian

Counselor Woodward specializes in real estate law, zoning issues, estate planning, probate, business law, and local government law. February 8, 2023 Barry Lewin Docent Holocaust Museum & Cohen Education Center

Our February speaker, Barry Lewin, has first-hand knowledge of the Holocaust, having family that fell victim to it. Mr. Lewin will provide an intimate account, replete with video, of the suffering.

The Holocaust Museum serves more than 30,000 students and visitors annually at the Museum, at schools, and in the community. The Museum is consistently ranked in the top 10 best places to visit in Naples on TripAdvisor.

With an eye to the future, the Museum conducted a successful capital campaign, purchased and moved to a larger facility. The new, larger Museum is nearly 10,000 square feet and includes its permanent collection with artifacts and stories from local Survivors and Liberators, special temporary exhibits, and classroom space for student programs and lectures. The Museum partners with many local groups in its mission to teach the lessons of the Holocaust to inspire action against bigotry, hatred and violence.

I am pleased to announce that our April speaker will be Ms. Sarah Falkowski, one of the fine docents that educate thousands of visitors each year for the Rookery Bay Reserve. She comes to us with vast experience and knowledge of the natural environment that surrounds us. I want to personally thank <u>Dave</u> <u>Walsh</u> for this wonderful speaker recommendation!

Managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in partnership with the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration and Florida International University, the Reserve is responsible for managing wildlife and habitat within its 110,000 acres boundary, which stretches from downtown Naples eastward through the Western Everglades, encompassing 40 percent of Collier County's coastline! The Reserve operates programs in coastal research and monitoring, land and water resource management, and environmental learning and decisionmaker training at the Rookery Bay Environmental Learning Center.


