
The Golf boys are at the range getting their slice under control for the Winter Golf Championship starting Feb 13th.



February 8, 2023 Barry Lewin Docent Holocaust Museum & Cohen Education Center

Our February speaker, Barry Lewin, has first-hand knowledge of the Holocaust, having family that fell victim to it. Mr. Lewin will provide an intimate account, replete with video, of the suffering.

The Holocaust Museum serves more than 30,000 students and visitors annually at the Museum, at schools, and in the community. The Museum is consistently ranked in the top 10 best places to visit in Naples on TripAdvisor.

With an eye to the future, the Museum conducted a successful capital campaign, purchased and moved to a larger facility. The new, larger Museum is nearly 10,000 square feet and includes its permanent collection with artifacts and stories from local Survivors and Liberators, special temporary exhibits, and classroom space for student programs and lectures. The Museum partners with many local groups in its mission to teach the lessons of the Holocaust to inspire action against bigotry, hatred and violence.

The Revs Institute and Research Library, located in Naples, FL is three stories of living automotive history. There, you will discover a mint collection of rare automotive treasures and related objects and artifacts that changed the course of human history. Within the Miles Collier Collections, you can see more than 100 automobiles that are divided into four thematic galleries: Automobility, Vitesse, Revs, and Porsche. The automobiles are fully operational and displayed free of protective barriers, allowing visitors intimate access.

As stated above, Tom Dussault is an active member of the Revs Institute. He is also one of their premier docents. Tom, a former attorney from the Boston, MA area, came to live in Naples, FL with his wife Mary eight years ago. In 2019, he joined a group of volunteers at the institute and the rest is history! (No pun intended!) His topic: <u>Revs Institute -</u> <u>Preserving the Future of the Past</u>.

In recent years, our club has visited this incredible facility! Perhaps those of you thinking about hosting an MMC event might consider a trip to the Revs Institute!

This will be a most informative and enjoyable presentation, replete with photos and videos of some really classic automobiles!

April 12, 2023 Tom Williams Author, Featured Writer, Marco Beach Boy

Among other things, Tom Williams is a novelist and creative writer. He is the author of the Beach Boy Chronicles featured as a weekly column in Marco Island's Coastal Breeze. In 2023, Tom is celebrating 38 years as a US Coast Guard licensed sailboat captain on Marco Island. He is a veteran scuba diver specializing in shipwreck diving with a keen interest in deep-sea archeology. Also known as Capt. Tom, Williams has skippered guests for sailing excursions out of the Marriott Island Beach Resort aboard a 9-meter catamaran for 3 decades. May 10, 2023 Sarah Falkowski Docent Rookery Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve

I am pleased to announce that our April speaker will be Ms. Sarah Falkowski, one of the fine docents that educate thousands of visitors each year for the Rookery Bay Reserve. She comes to us with vast experience and knowledge of the natural environment that surrounds us. I want to personally thank <u>Dave</u> <u>Walsh</u> for this wonderful speaker recommendation!

Managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in partnership with the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration and Florida International University, the Reserve is responsible for managing wildlife and habitat within its 110,000 acres boundary, which stretches from downtown Naples eastward through the Western Everglades, encompassing 40 percent of Collier County's coastline! The Reserve operates programs in coastal research and monitoring, land and water resource management, and environmental learning and decisionmaker training at the Rookery Bay Environmental Learning Center.

A ministry of Wesley United Methodist Church in partnership with the Marcoarea community, MDR is held on Mondays from 10:30 AM until 2:30 PM at Wesley United Methodist Church (Fellowship Hall). They will be adding a second day of programming (Fridays) in early 2023.

The Spring Scramble is going to be Friday, April 28th at The Glades with an 8:30AM shotgun start.


