


Go to the HOME PAGE (<u>https://marcomensclub.com/</u>) from anywhere in the website and look for this image on the left, near the top of the page.



#### May 10, 2023 Sarah Falkowski Docent Rookery Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve

I am pleased to announce that our May speaker will be Ms. Sarah Falkowski, one of the fine docents that educate thousands of visitors each year for the Rookery Bay Reserve. She comes to us with vast experience and knowledge of the natural environment that surrounds us. I want to personally thank <u>Dave</u> <u>Walsh</u> for this wonderful speaker recommendation!

Managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in partnership with the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration and Florida International University, the Reserve is responsible for managing wildlife and habitat within its 110,000 acres boundary, which stretches from downtown Naples eastward through the Western Everglades, encompassing 40 percent of Collier County's coastline! The Reserve operates programs in coastal research and monitoring, land and water resource management, and environmental learning and decisionmaker training at the Rookery Bay Environmental Learning Center.

Early in 2022, they formed a broad-based coalition that led to the creation of MDR, a new local charity *for <u>Marco area residents</u>* with early-stage Alzheimer's/Dementia and their caregivers... Services provided <u>by</u> <u>Marco area residents</u>. Marco Dementia Respite (MDR) exists to provide a safe pasis for Marco-area

to provide a safe oasis for Marco-area residents with early-stage Alzheimer's/Dementia at no cost to the participant. They respond as well to a critical need for caregiver respite on Marco and formulating a more unified approach to senior care island wide. A ministry of Wesley United Methodist Church in partnership with the Marcoarea community, MDR is held on Mondays from 10:30 AM until 2:30 PM at Wesley United Methodist Church (Fellowship Hall). They will be adding a second day of programming (Fridays) in early 2023.

# 'Addressing the needs of those facing hunger in Collier County.'

Amanda Nelson is the Executive Director of Our Daily Bread Food Pantry. Ms. Nelson has over 30 years of Non-Profit leadership experience, most recently serving as the Executive Director of a Breast Cancer organization in Sacramento, CA. From AIDS to the arts to the environment, Amanda has made a career out of taking organizations to the next level, improving programs, mentoring staff, strengthening boards and growing donations and fundraising efforts.

Launched in 2016, The Pantry began serving the needs of school children on weekends by providing backpacks stuffed with food on Fridays. Since then, it has grown its services to include:

- A Saturday drive-through food pantry on Winterberry Drive.
- ➤ 15 mobile outreaches.
- A monthly Senior luncheon (Lunch with Friends) in partnership with the YMCA of Collier County.
- A Backpack Program for Manatee Elementary and Middle School as well as Marco Island Charter Middle School.
- A weekly Breakfast program for Marco Island Charter Middle School.
- Other strategic partnerships to provide for needs beyond nourishment.

Beginning in 2022, Our Daily Bread Food Pantry began fundraising to expand to a second location in order to continue providing critical food assistance to the over 152,000 individuals served in 2021.

We are honored to host Mr. Richard Heinrich, today!... Richard, a long-time Marco resident, is of the many fine docents you encounter upon entering The Naples Museum of Military History. Imbued with thousands of military artifacts from all branches of the US Military, the museum is located on the grounds of the Naples Municipal Airport. The airport was originally constructed by the Army Corps of Engineers to train pilots for the Pacific theater in WWII. The museum displays military photos, medals, leather flight jackets, uniforms, field equipment, aircraft, ship and vehicle models, helmets, weapons, trench-art, newspaper clippings and much more. As many as 5,000 of the museum's 12,000 artifacts honor veterans and create a greater understanding of military conflicts among present and future generations. What began as a museum honoring military aviation in World War II, has evolved into so much more. You can now see historical artifacts dating back to the Revolutionary War all the way up to the Iraq & Afghanistan conflicts.

I am sure this talk will stir many memories in those of you who served or have family and friends that served. Please be sure to show your support by attending this special presentation.


