

July 12, 2023 Nancy Kot President Our Daily Bread Food Pantry

'Addressing the needs of those facing hunger in Collier County.'

Nancy Kot is currently the President of ODBFP and has been a volunteer for over 7 years. Her main focus area of responsibility is Operations, Volunteer Coordination, & Strategic Planning, which includes the search for a permanent location for The Pantry. Launched in 2016, The Pantry began serving the needs of school children on weekends by providing backpacks stuffed with food on Fridays. Since then, it has grown its services to include:

- A Saturday drive-through food pantry on Winterberry Drive.
- ▶ 15 mobile outreaches.
- A monthly Senior luncheon (Lunch with Friends) in partnership with the YMCA of Collier County.
- A Backpack Program for Manatee Elementary and Middle School as well as Marco Island Charter Middle School.

- A weekly Breakfast program for Marco Island Charter Middle School.
- Other strategic partnerships to provide for needs beyond nourishment.

Beginning in 2022, Our Daily Bread Food Pantry began fundraising to expand to a second location in order to continue providing critical food assistance to the over 152,000 individuals served in 2021.

We are honored to host Mr. Richard Heinrich, today!... Richard, a long-time Marco resident, is of the many fine docents you encounter upon entering The Naples Museum of Military History. Imbued with thousands of military artifacts from all branches of the US Military, the museum is located on the grounds of the Naples Municipal Airport. The airport was originally constructed by the Army Corps of Engineers to train pilots for the Pacific theater in WWII. The museum displays military photos, medals, leather flight jackets, uniforms, field equipment, aircraft, ship and vehicle models, helmets, weapons, trench-art, newspaper clippings and much more. As many as 5,000 of the museum's 12,000 artifacts honor veterans and create a greater understanding of military conflicts among present and future generations. What began as a museum honoring military aviation in World War II, has evolved into so much more. You can now see historical artifacts dating back to the Revolutionary War all the way up to the Iraq & Afghanistan conflicts.

I am sure this talk will stir many memories in those of you who served or have family and friends that served. Please be sure to show your support by attending this special presentation.

Our July Friday coordinator, **Bob Boland**, has scheduled the following courses:


