In addition, save the date of Tuesday, December 12th for our annual Holiday Luncheon at Naples Lakes.

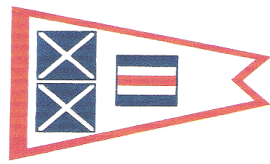
A few weeks ago, we sent a blast announcing the Men's Club Theatre Season and looking for hosts.

INVESTMENT DISCUSSION CLUB



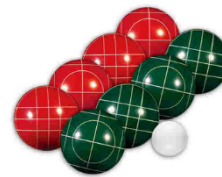
This is a gathering where opinions are valued, facts are appreciated and experience is not

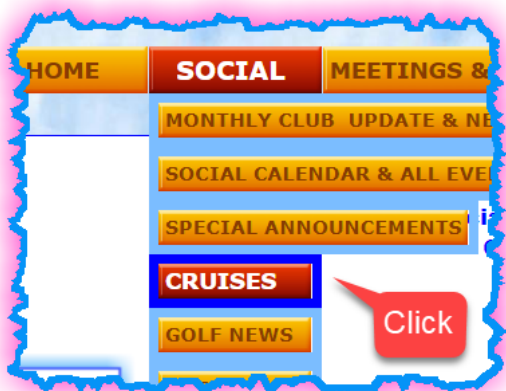

The Naples Museum of Military History

'MY BROTHER'S CLOSET'

We are honored to host Lt. Commander Richard Heinrich, today!... Richard, a long-time Marco resident, is one of the many fine docents you encounter upon entering The Naples Museum of Military History. A 1962 graduate of Texas A&M, he enlisted in the US Coast Guard and attained Chief Boatswain's Mate in 1970 (E-7). In 1971, Richard accepted a direct commission, discharged as Chief on a Saturday and commissioned as an Ensign (O-1) on Sunday. He retired for the first time in 1983 as Lt. Commander and was recalled in 1984. In 1990, Richard transferred to Active Status Pool pending retirement in 1992 (O-5) His specialty in civilian life was environmental safety in construction and general industry. In 1999, Lt. Commander Heinrich retired to Marco Island.

Imbued with thousands of military artifacts from all branches of the US Military, the museum is located on the

grounds of the Naples Municipal Airport. The airport was originally constructed by the Army Corps of Engineers to train pilots for the Pacific theater in WWII. The museum displays military photos, medals, leather flight jackets, uniforms, field equipment, aircraft, ship and vehicle models, helmets, weapons, trench-art, newspaper clippings and much more. As many as 5,000 of the museum's 12,000 artifacts honor veterans and create a greater understanding of military conflicts among present and future generations. What began as a museum honoring military aviation in World War II, has evolved into so much more. You can now see historical artifacts dating back to the Revolutionary War all the way up to the Iraq & Afghanistan conflicts.

I am sure this talk will stir many memories in those of you who served or have family and friends that served. Please be sure to show your support by attending this special presentation.

Our August Friday coordinator, Glenn Davis, has scheduled the following courses:

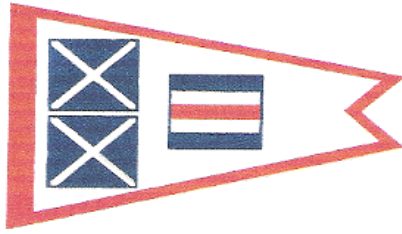
