Also, November brings dues renewal. There will be a blast regarding this when the website is ready to take your on-line payment!


Finally, October 30th is National Candy Corn Day! For 140 years we have been loving or hating this treat!

Early in 2022, they formed a broad-based coalition that led to the creation of MDR, a new local charity *for Marco area residents* with early-stage Alzheimer's/Dementia and their caregivers... Services provided *by Marco area residents*.

Marco Dementia Respite (MDR) exists

to provide a safe oasis for Marco-area residents with early-stage
Alzheimer's/Dementia at no cost to the participant. They respond as well to a critical need for caregiver respite on Marco and formulating a more unified approach to senior care island wide. A ministry of Wesley United Methodist Church in partnership with the Marco-area community, MDR is held on Mondays from 10:30 AM until 2:30 PM at Wesley United Methodist Church (Fellowship Hall). They will be adding a

second day of programming (Fridays) in early 2023.

I am very pleased to have Ms. Dianna Dohm, Executive Director of the Marco Island Chamber of Commerce, address the MMC membership on this date regarding an exciting new initiative...

Marco Island residents are soon to be the benefactors of an expanded urgent care center!

The current NCH Healthcare System's Urgent Care Center will be replaced, and longtime supporters are helping with the expense, which includes a private matching grant of five million dollars toward construction. The project cost of nearly \$18 million involves a two-story building at NCH's Marco campus at 40 South Heathwood Drive. The new center will encompass 24,000 square feet, with

the second floor of 12,000 square feet left as a shell for future use.

The current center is more than 30 years old and new construction is needed in order to keep pace with our community's growth. With a population of 18,000 on Marco, the urgent care center is currently open daily and sees 45 patients a day during season. The number drops to 25 patients in the slower summer months.

THE STATE OF EDUCATION IN COLLIER COUNTY

Dr. Ricciardelli is the 20th superintendent of the Arated Collier County Public School District (CCPS), which, in 2023, celebrates 100 years of excellence in education. CCPS is responsible for educating approximately 50,000 students and employing slightly under 7,000 fulland part-time employees. Dr. Ricciardelli's experiences and expertise within the district and the community have provided her with an in-depth understanding of the expectations and values the people of Collier County have of our public education system.

Earlier in her career, Dr. Ricciardelli worked in three other Florida counties — Broward, Orange, and Seminole where she served as a teacher for students with disabilities and returned to Collier County to work as an inclusion teacher. Dr. Ricciardelli has served in a variety of capacities: exceptional student education assistant, teacher, assistant principal, principal, and various district leadership roles where she led in a variety of positions, including Executive Director for Secondary Programs, School Leadership and Performance Officer, and Deputy Superintendent. Securing the Integrity of the Collier County Voting Process

Melissa Blazier was appointed as Collier County Supervisor of Elections by Governor DeSantis in May 2023. She has worked for the Supervisor of Elections office since 2006 most recently serving as Chief Deputy Supervisor of Elections under Jennifer J. Edwards.

Blazier holds a bachelor's degree in business administration, magna cum laude, from Hodges University. She received her designation as a Certified Elections/Registration Administrator (CERA) from the National Association of Election Officials (Election Center) and is a Master Florida Certified Elections Professional (MFCEP) through the Florida Supervisors of Elections (FSE).

She is a graduate of the Associate Leadership Collier program spring class of 2010, Leadership Collier class of 2014 and Leadership Marco class of 2019. Melissa was named one of Gulf Shore Business's Top Forty under 40 in 2014, Distinguished Fundraising Volunteer via the Association of Fundraising Professionals in 2018, the Leadership Collier Foundation's Volunteer of the Year in 2020 and was most recently named Kiwanian of the Year by the Kiwanis Club of Naples in 2022.

Blazier is a member of the American Legion Auxiliary Post 135, Election Center, Kiwanis Club of Naples, Leadership Collier Alumni Association, League of Women Voters, Men's Republican Club of Collier County, Naples Republican Club, Republican Club of South Collier County, Republican Women of Southwest Florida Federated, and the Women's Republican Club. She currently serves on the Leadership Collier Foundation Advisory Council and is President of the Kiwanis Club of Naples.

February 14, 2024 Brittany Piersma Field Biologist Audubon Western Everglades (AWE)

I am pleased to present our Valentine's Day speaker, Ms. Brittany Piersma! Brittany will speak to the membership regarding the 3 critical conservation projects here on Marco: Burrowing Owls, Gopher Tortoises and Shorebirds.

Brittany has a BS in Environmental Science and previously worked as a zookeeper at the Naples Zoo for 4 years. She has a wide range of experience with Southwest Florida's wildlife from volunteering with FWC (Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission), Rookery Bay, Panther Refuge, and Audubon.

Ms. Piersma worked as FWC's Critical Wildlife Area Shorebird Biologist for the last three summers on Marco Island, where she monitored nesting shorebirds out on Sand Dollar. The last two winters she worked as a Shorebird Steward for Audubon Western Everglades surveying the migratory flocks, training volunteers, and doing outreach with the public.

As Field Biologist for AWE, Brittany maintains continuing wintering bird surveys, assists with the burrowing owl program as well as our new Gopher Tortoise land study.


